## OUR WORK

### **Awareness & Education**

Working in partnership with libraries and the community, TMKTR creates awareness about reading issues like dyslexia and provides information about resources that help all children become skilled readers.

Libraries signed up for The Road to Decode receive education about the process of how we learn to read, and where the different resources fit. Through TMKTR partners, TMKTR helps libraries that may not otherwise have access to decodable books, create decodable book sections in their library.

### **Support & Guidance**

The Roadmap to Reading program is a train-the-trainer model to help libraries initiate literacy programming for parents and caregivers. TMKTR provide virtual support and trouble-shooting.

### **Webinars & Courses**

Professional Webinars and online courses are offered regularly to help parents, caregivers, librarians and educators learn more about ways to help children improve their reading and language skills.

### **Legislative Advocacy**

Supporting policies that promote better literacy outcomes for all children.
