## What is a Community (Decodable) Literacy Hub?

A Community Literacy Hub is a dedicated space in your library with **decodable books** to support early and struggling readers and **literacy tools** for families and educators to support their reader.

### A Community (Decodable) Literacy Hub includes:

**Decodable Book Collections** Books aligned to phonics skills, proven to help children break the code and read!

**Educator & Family Resources** Literacy resources for parents/caregivers to learn about the most efficient ways to support literacy for their learner.

**Library Materials** Bins, signs, brochures, handouts and other tools to help librarians manage the Hub and explain Hub content to patrons.

## Why it matters:

*Libraries provide equitable access to resources that work for all readers.*

While libraries contain a myriad of materials and programs, they are frequently missing the books that act as training wheels for a reader just learning to break the code.

**Decodable books help all. Without them, and the appropriate instruction, many children, especially those with dyslexia or other challenges, are left behind.**
